- The lower parts of buildings and columns: often coloured dark red.
- Roof tiles, bowls and jugs: orange-red terracotta.
- Shoppers and girls playing knucklebones: red, green or yellow.
- Poor people: undyed cream or brown wool.
- Cart: made of wood.
- Turnips the boy is selling in his basket: white, cream or yellow.
